Pleased be reminded that when you were in Liberia, I discussed with you concerning the increment in school fees due to high exchange rate between the Liberian dollars and the u.s.dollars which makes the prices on the market to be very high and Government has also warned all schools to improve their learning facilities and move from mat structures to building. All these factors contribute to the increment of tuitions.

In view of the above, we wish to appeal for increment in the school fees as follows:

1. kindergarten- 7th grade 45 USD PER SEM.
2. 8TH - 12TH GRADE 50 USD PER SEM. \
